## ACCELERATED DUAL-DEGREE IN THEATER/MS OR MA IN COMMUNICATIONS (3+1)

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The College of Arts & Sciences is no longer accepting students into the theater major. Students who are interested in studying theater should consider the minor (http://catalog.qu.edu/arts-sciences/visual-performing-arts/theater-minor/) which is open to all students.

Upon completion of the BA in Theater, students will develop the following competencies:

- 1. **Understanding:** Develop an understanding of the roles and responsibilities of theater artists: actor, director, scenic/lighting/costume designer, technical director and playwright.
- 2. **Conceptual and Critical Thinking:** Develop skills to think conceptually and critically about text, performance and production.
- Self-Appraisal: Develop the skills to self-assess, critique and revise their own work.
- 4. **Literacy:** Develop a fundamental knowledge of theatrical history as well as dramatic literature.
- Production Skills and Knowledge: Develop the skills and techniques necessary for realizing a variety of theatrical styles.
- 6. Collaboration Skills: Develop skills in collective problem-solving.
